Did you know: Your [redacted] provides technical assistance to landowners, farm operations and municipalities free of charge? If you are interested in making improvements to or addressing concerns with your [redacted] please contact the District. This brief update highlights two projects and [redacted] s making it all possible Above Jaycox Creek project: highlights a series of 8 [redacted] placed within the landscape to alleviate flooding associated with larger storm events. Requiring coordination, dedication of time, labor and the finances from 4 separate landowners. Work began in early 2020. The result: 9 million gallons of [redacted] " has been established. Providing significant "relief" to numerous commercial and residential properties located immediately down stream. ....

Conesus Lake Watershed Update: Webb Farm: Work culminated on this scenic 78 acre farmstead located on East. Lake Road, Livonia in January 2023. Five years ago Mr. Webb sought District assistance to implement best management practices on his farm. Hands on, the entire Webb family providing significant amounts of time / labor, machinery and the finances to make it all possible. Most recently 3 acres field borders and contour terracing were installed. In 2020, a large dry "detention basin" was nestled into the farm's landscape, capable of safely addressing a "100 yr. storm event". Two more water and sediment control basins and a permanent grass buffer strip along a 1,800 ft. stretch of active stream were also established in 2022. Thank you all. Great job!
